Position Overview

Set up machines to run the different operations/jobs and ensure that a quality product is produced in the most efficient and cost-effective manner.

- Follow up DCP and blueprint requirements to produce a quality part; this requires making all tool adjustments, offsets and troubleshooting.

- Perform all necessary quality checks using micrometer, calipers, gages and Keyence measuring machine.
- Responsible for operating the machines, which includes stocking and loading the machine, keeping it filled with proper oil levels, cutting fluids or lube and keep the machine.
