Position Overview

Maintains production and quality by ensuring operation of machinery and mechanical equipment, Major electrical knowledge, ensures compliance of all Safety, environmental, and other workspaces with safety and environmental standards.

Essential Job Functions and Responsibilities

Journeyman level knowledge of Machine, and Facilities Electrical.

Ability to read, and understand machine-wiring schematics, size components to meet requirements of equipment. Ensures operation of machinery electrical components by completing preventive maintenance requirements on electrical motors, Controls and sensors for all production machines; following diagrams, sketches, operations manuals, manufacturer's instructions, and engineering specifications; troubleshooting malfunctions.

Locate sources of problems by observing electrical devices in operation; listening for problems. Removes defective parts by dismantling devices, using hand on hand power tools; examining form and texture of parts.

Determines changes in operational requirements of parts by inspecting used parts; using the correct, electrical test equipment.

Controls downtime by informing production workers of routine preventive maintenance techniques; monitoring compliance.

Maintains equipment, parts, and supplies inventories by checking stock to determine inventory level; anticipating needed equipment, parts, and supplies; placing and expediting orders; verifying receipts.

Provides electrical maintenance information by answering questions and requests.

Maintains continuity among work teams by documenting and communicating actions, irregularities and continuing needs.
