Position Overview

Sets up and operates a hand operated pointing machine, using tools and gages to meet specified parts tolerance as called out on the blue print and job router. May monitor and verify quality in accordance with statistical process and Keyence measurement machine.

Essential Job Functions and Responsibilities

- Observes cutting tools in operation to ensure proper functioning and replaces, sharpens and resets them as necessary.
- Examines samples from each machine for burrs, ragged edges or scratches and determines that dimensions are within prescribed tolerances, using variety of gauges and measuring tools.
- Read and understands instructions, procedures, routing sheets and other required documentation.
- Follows instructions and procedures to ensure that quality of work is met.

Scope

• This position reports to the Manufacturing Supervisor and does not have any direct report.

Requirements / Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age
- High School diploma/GED
- Blue print reading skills

Preferred Qualifications

• 1-2 years experience /knowledge of machining.

Physical Requirements
