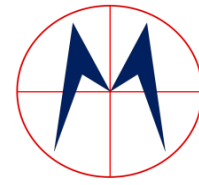

Essential Job Functions and Responsibilities

- Clean parts between process operations and perform final cleaning.

Scope

- This position reports to Heat Treat Supervisor and does not have any direct reports.

Requirements / Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- High School Diploma/ GED.
- Employee must show aptitude for machining. A willingness to perform the physical functions required.
- Positive attitude and readily volunteers assistance and seeks training opportunities.

Preferred Qualifications

- Completion of formal apprentice or equivalent training experience.

Physical Requirements

- Employee is required to stand for long periods of time. Must be able to walk and lift or carry parts or other items weighing up to 40lbs throughout the department. Uses arms, hands, and fingers to operate machinery and use tools, computers and other equipment.

- Primary work is done machine shop condition. Noise level is high. Employee is exposed to chemicals, moving machinery and equipments.
