Position Overview

Under close supervision, performs basic nondestructive testing. Uses conventional FPI methods.

Essential Job Functions and Responsibilities

- Conducts and documents tests on parts and assemblies to verify product conformance.
- Works under the direction of higher NDT technicians to process products through NDT applicable NDT methods.
- Identifies opportunities for improving processes, procedures or equipment.
- Maintains a clean work environment including assigned storage and cleaning duties in full compliance with company standards, customers.

Scope

- This position reports to NDT level III and does not have direct reports.

Requirements / Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- High School Diploma / GED.
- Good vision with correction must not be color blind.
- Employee must show aptitude for machining. A willingness to perform the physical functions required.
- Positive attitude and readily volunteers assistance and seeks training opportunities.

Preferred Qualifications

- NDT experience /knowledge a plus.
- Knowledge of conventional and automated, robotic testing systems, good communications skills, computer skills and the ability to work effectively as a team member.

Physical Requirements

- Ability to stand for long periods of time.
- Lift up to 40 pounds.
- Withstand load noise of a machine environment.
- Good vision with correction- must not be color blind.

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Work Environment

- Primary is done under machine shop conditions. Noise level is high. Employee is exposed to chemicals, moving machinery or equipment.
